TRANSPORT

TRANSLINK - GO CARD

go card is Translink's electronic ticket to fast, easy and convenient travel in South East Queensland.

Use go card on all Translink bus, train (including Airtrain), ferry and tram services in greater Brisbane, Ipswich, Sunshine Coast, and Gold Coast regions.

The best part about go card is it's:

- cheaper than a paper ticket
- convenient to manage
- easy to top-up and use
- available for adults, children, concessions, seniors.

You can purchase a go card from the **Union College Office for \$15** then you will need to register it, activate and add funds to your card. Please see the directions below and ensure you enter your student number so you can apply for a concession fare.



PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARD

The photo identification card:

- provides proof of age for Queenslanders aged 15 years or older
- is an ideal form of photo identification for people who are not old enough to get a driver licence or don't hold a driver licence or passport.



Apply for a photo identification card

You can apply in person for a photo identification card at a transport and motoring customer service centre, participating Queensland Government Agency Program Office (QGAP), or a police station that provides licensing services.

To apply for the card you must:

- be at least 15 years of age
- complete the photo identification card application (F4772)
- provide evidence of identity
- pay the fee.

You may need to have your photo taken when you apply for a photo identification card. You will not receive your card straight away, it will be sent you by mail by standard post.

When you apply for your photo identification card you will be asked if you want your residential address to be shown on the back of your card.
